



Sports Premium Funding 2018/2019

Reaside Academy has been allocated £17,910 from the government for the 2018/19 academic year to improve the quality and breadth of sport provision within our school.

At Reaside Academy we aim to establish a sporting culture that enables and encourages all children to play and enjoy sport.

Please find detailed below how we have decided to spend this money to ensure that this funding has the greatest impact on improving the breadth and quality of P.E. offered by our school.

Sports Plus Scheme

- Deliver four weekly after-school Multi-Skills clubs for all our children from Year 3 – Year 6 throughout the year.
- Four weekly lunchtime activities for all our children from Year 3- 6 throughout the year.
- Teach four afternoons each week – one afternoon per year group.
- Provide weekly football training sessions (Year 5 /6 children) playing competitively against other local schools in preparation for matches and competitions against other schools in the local district.
- Organise and run additional clubs for all children aged 7-11 to attend (at an additional cost)
- Providing whole school twilight training for all staff in an area of P.E. that the audit shows up as being most needed.
- The qualified Sports Plus coach working alongside Teachers and TAs to increase subject knowledge and confidence in delivering P.E. lessons
- The children in year 3 – 6 identified as being Gifted and Talented in P.E. take part in an additional weekly lesson where they receive intensive coaching and support.

CPD Training

- The school's P.E. co-ordinator to attend two courses to enhance her knowledge of the National Curriculum for P.E. as well as to learn about opportunities for after-school activities within the local cluster of schools.

Competitive KS2 Sports Day (to be held in July 2018)

- Set up costs including equipment, stickers, engraving of trophy etc.
